Thank you for your wiliness to be a member of the scientific committee of our International Journal of Applied Information and Communication Technology [IJOAICT]. The membership is free of charge and per one year. If you would like to continuo the membership, you will be asked to send again the “Annual declaration of INBIE scientific committee member’s interest”.

What is the process?

- 1. Send an e-mail (contact@ihoaict.inbie.pl) to the Chairmen of the Scientific Committee Mr. Luis Ochoa Siguencia PhD., expressing your wiliness to be part of the scientific committee.**
- 2. The Chairmen of the Scientific Committee will send you “The Annual declaration of INBIE scientific committee member’s interest [ADSCM]” document.**
- 3. If you agree, you should sign the ADSCM and send it back a pdf copy by e-mail.**
- 4. A short scientific achievements - interest report [10-15 lines] should be sent together with the ADSCM.**
- 5. “Research and Innovation in Education Institute” members of the Board will analyse your scientific achievements and short curriculum vitae and send you the final decision.**
- 6. All the process should not last more than five working days.**

Important:

- The President of INBIE appoints the Chairmen of the Scientific Committee
- The Chairmen of the Scientific Committee accepts the candidates / membership for the INBIE Scientific Committee and appoints the secretary in consultation with Committee members
- The Scientific Committee will be engaged in the peer review process (Double Blind Review)
- As there is not a financial commitment, a member can withdraw his membership from the Scientific Committee by e-mail.
- All claims or disputes between the Parties arising out of or in connection with this declaration, including concerning its validity and construction, that cannot be resolved amicably will be submitted for resolution by a common court having jurisdiction in Czestochowa - Poland.
